Description:	Hi, Couldn't check on this chiliproject if you have the same issue. In Google Chrome (as well as Firefox 13a1), the progress bar doesn't display a filling. A quick look with the developer tools seems to show that the style rule is overridden by another rule (see attached screenshot).
