Thanks for taking the time to report and confirm this bug.

I have spent some time to look into it. Below are some hints for the Chili maintainers, so they may save some minutes.

To reproduce the problem, you need to enable email notifications for `_Document added_`. It was introduced by the "one mail per recipient" feature. There seems to be no test case which covers adding an attachment to document. The diff below seems to fix the problem.
