So this is going to get really tricky: the @ChangesetJournal@ s are created as the user currently logged in when they are created, and that's what the activity filters by, those should be the id of the committer though. One thing though: that will only apply if the committer is found at the @Changeset@ creation time, if you add a link between an SCM and a ChiliProject user (project's repository settings) afterward, it won't link the Journal to that user.
