Description: Using Firefox 13.0.1, and Chromium 18.0.1025.168 browsers on Linux and noticing that when clicking any link in chiliproject 3.x with the new theme, the entire browser flashes white as a new page renders. This does not happen when browsing with javascript disabled via no script. On a fast server and connection it is mildly annoying - on a slow Chiliproject instance the white browser flash lasts for enough time to be visually jarring.
