Eg. If I have a project "Contracts" and this project has subproject "Foo Application". And I would like to add a subproject "iOS" to project "Foo Application", the generated project identifier is "ios". But it would be much more usefull if it could be eg. "contracts-foo-application-ios".

Is this possible? I use subprojects heavily and this would save me much time for renaming project identifiers when creating them.
