The problem with the "More" Menu is: Its not intuitive and handy for items which are used quite often.

All of our users are dissatisfied with this new menu - so we had to adapt the menubar by inserting new items via JavaScript.

It would be better, if plugins have a chance to extend existing menus and the sidebar - the current limitation is to hard and loses the focus on usability.

Sorry for this critique - but anyone I asked and some users here (see the theme discussions inside tickets and the forum) think the same way.

Maybe there's a way to do both: Offering hooks for the "More" menu and optionally hooks for sidebar/menubar?
