Description:	The HTML5 calendar of Chrome 22 doesn't start with the day listed in the application settings. So if I set it to start on Sunday for instance, the calendar still shows up as starting on Monday.

It seems the "date input type":[http://dev.w3.org/html5/spec/single-page.html#date-state-\(type=date\)](http://dev.w3.org/html5/spec/single-page.html#date-state-(type=date)) used for this doesn't allow to set a start-of-week day, so I guess the browser shows the calendar wrt the language you are using the browser in. If this is not the case for Chrome I'd say it's a bug on their side.
