I had set up the WLAN and had installed a few custom android app. The stick had become very warm (my guess would be 60C or a little more), was uncomfortable to touch. The laptop then shut itself down, and would not restart with the stick inserted. This usually happens if there is some form of short on a USB device. Attached to another PC the same shutdown occurs, and attached to a montior and powered from USB there is no signal from the HDMI port.
