I think doing some blog posts on all of the SCM integration would be a good thing. Basic (Repo module), repoman.rb, Redmine.pm for svn, Redmine.pm for git, and Redmine.pm with LDAP. I think it would be best to rename and update all of the modules first (e.g. @extras/scm/ChiliProject.pm@).
