<b>Description:</b>	Rails 2.3.11 is said to not work with RubyGems 1.8.5. Also there is "an edge-case XSS vulnerability": <a href="http://groups.google.com/group/rubyonrails-security/browse_thread/thread/2e516e7acc96c4fb">http://groups.google.com/group/rubyonrails-security/browse_thread/thread/2e516e7acc96c4fb</a> in Rails 2.3.11.  "Rails 2.3.12": <a href="http://rubygems.org/gems/rails/versions/2.3.12">http://rubygems.org/gems/rails/versions/2.3.12</a> should fix the above issues.  I propose waiting for another two days before updating (since the Rails team tends to screw their 2.3.x releases) but this should definitely become part of Chili 2.0.
