Description: <p>In the project overview the current project members are displayed. But the project manager has the ability to assign permissions both per user and per group. If a group contains a lot of users this could be hard to get a good overview of which group got assigned which permissions.</p> <p>h2. Example:</p> <p>Lets say that we have Three groups:</p> <p>+Group A:+ * User 1 * User 2 * User 3</p> <p>+Group B:+ * User 4 * User 5</p> <p>+Group C:+ * User 6 * User 7 * User 8</p> <p>In the project User 3 is the project manager and group A and B and User 6 have developer permissions and group C has report permissions.</p> <p>In the current project overview this would display the permissions as:</p> <p>*Manager:* User 3 *Developer:* User 1, User 2, User 4, User 5, User 6 *Reporter:* User 7, User 8</p> <p>With my suggested option, you could choose to display the information as:</p> <p>*Manager:* User 3 *Developer:* +Group A+, +Group B+, User 6 *Reporter:* +Group C+</p> <p>One additional feature would be to expand the group and show its contents by clicking on the group name.</p>
