Description: Yet another encoding problem from using ruby 1.9: rails 2.3.x considers user input as byte strings, in

particular the content of the params hash, which yields an Encoding error every time an input string is

concatenated to an existing string.

change of 2.3.10 to 2.3.12.

Note: this fix assumes that the user wants to use UTF-8 as the default encoding, which I believe is a

reasonable default.
