<b>Description:</b> The Diff view of an git commit shows deleted files as changes to the file /dev/null.			
Steps to reproduce:			
* git rm \$file && git commit && git push			
* Open the repository view in cp			
* Click "show differences" ("Unterschiede anzeigen")
