Executing <code>*bundle install*</code> does not reach any <code>*gem "&lt;database&gt;"</code> related lines because of missing a suitable platform block (e.g. <code>mswin</code> or <code>mingw_18</code> ) in Gemfile.			
That could end up in a error message like this:
