Description:	When multiple classes are defined within one file, this tends to mess up Rails autoloading in development - especially when plugins try to redefine/patch these models. The (to be) attached pull request simply moves the models into separate, properly named files. I propose to keep this change for Chili 3.0 since it might change the autoloading some plugins could rely on. It should therefore be safer to wait for a major release.
