Description:			
The project navigation presented in the new design (see #263) demands some space. For users sitting in front of a small screen or for views which demand as much space as possible, this could be a problem.			
Making the project navigation invisible would solve the problem, but isn't the navigation a feature the user should always have access to?			
An idea that solves both issues, is a collapsed project navigation which shows only the images of the menu-items.			
Clicking on the images opens the page or opens a sub-navigation layer.			
I added some screenshots to explain the idea. These are just quick mockups (far from perfect).			
The most important thing missing is the button to hide/show the project sidebar. It's still unclear where to place it.			
What do you think about that feature?
