

## ChiliProject - Bug # 711: translation missing: en, field\_lock\_version on issue edit on Ruby 1.9

<b>Description:</b>	When running on Ruby 1.9, the issue edit form has label "translation missing: en, field_lock_version" (see attached screenshot). This happens in our production instance as well as on a new, clean instance.  This has been reported in the Redmine tracker as well ( <a href="http://www.redmine.org/issues/6853">http://www.redmine.org/issues/6853</a> ).  The reason is a bug in @TabularFormBuilder@ that causes every hidden field to get label.
