If you try to set as parent task an issue from another project (or from the parent project) you get:

> `_Parent task doesn't belong to the same project_`

I also vote for this issue.

Typical need:

- # you have a project splitted into module
- # you need to fix a bug / implement a feature that interest more then one module
- # you'd like to create the `_parent_` issue on the main project
- # then create sub-tasks in the sub-project modules

This, combined with inherited permissions for parent --> children projects would be a very good improvement
