It appears that the system is ordering by last updated date but as you get into deeper pages of the search results things start to get a bit wonky. The order becomes skewed and the system displays search results that were displayed on a previous page.

This bug is fairly easy to reproduce:

```
# Go to https://www.chiliproject.org/projects/chiliproject/issues
# Search for "test"
# Note the last result (ATM it is https://www.chiliproject.org/issues/1112#note-2)
# Hit "Next" to see the next page
# Hit "Previous"
# Note the last result is not longer what it was (ATM it is https://www.chiliproject.org/issues/1119#note-1)
```

Repeating the Next/Previous cycle gives a different last item all the time. Also, the first pages only contains 8 results instead of 10 after one (and subsequent) Next/Previous cycle.
